Resolution No. M70-2022-P115

Adoption of Master Street Addressing Guide for the Pueblo of Zuni

WHEREAS, the Zuni Tribal Council consisting of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and six Tenientes is declared to be the legislative authority of the Pueblo of Zuni by Article V, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Zuni Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution, Article VI, the Tribal Council is authorized to act in all matters that concern the welfare of the Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Zuni Police Dispatch serves the Zuni Reservation and the Southern part of McKinley County and including Southern Cibola County which is part of the Zuni Reservation with Enhanced Landline, Wireless 9-1-1 Phase 1 & 2 services; and,

WHEREAS, the State of New Mexico 9-1-1 Rules and Regulations require that a 9-1-1 database, Master Street Addressing Guide (MSAG) and Automatic Location Identifier (ALI) be maintained at each Public Service Answering Point (PSAP) at a 96% or higher accuracy rate; and,

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Zuni Police Dispatch to maintain the MSAG and associated ALI Database at the 96% or higher accuracy rate and to appoint appropriate MSAG Director(s) to be responsible for meeting this requirement; and,

WHEREAS, the Pueblo of Zuni Police Dispatch & Geographic Information System (GIS) Office formed a committee to review and address the needs of updating the rural addressing; and,

WHEREAS, Zuni Police Dispatch and rural address committee have deemed the community of the Zuni Reservation in need of updated Master Street Addressing Guide (MSAG) to be compliant with E-911 standards; and,

WHEREAS, the Pueblo of Zuni Geographic Information System (GIS) Office in conjunction with the University of New Mexico Earth Data Analysis Center (EDAC) reviewed and completed the road inventory of adding new street names adjacent to existing roadways; and,


WHEREAS, the Pueblo of Zuni will be compliant with NM E-911 rules and regulations creating a better response for all public safety including all entities serving the Pueblo of Zuni; and,

WHEREAS, the Zuni Police Dispatch and Rural Address Committee hereby establishes an updated Master Street Addressing Guide for use and recommends all entities utilize the new street names.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Zuni Tribal Council adopts the Master Street Addressing Guide; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rural Address Committee will archive previously enacted MSAGs and move forward with the revised MSAG.




CERTIFICATION
